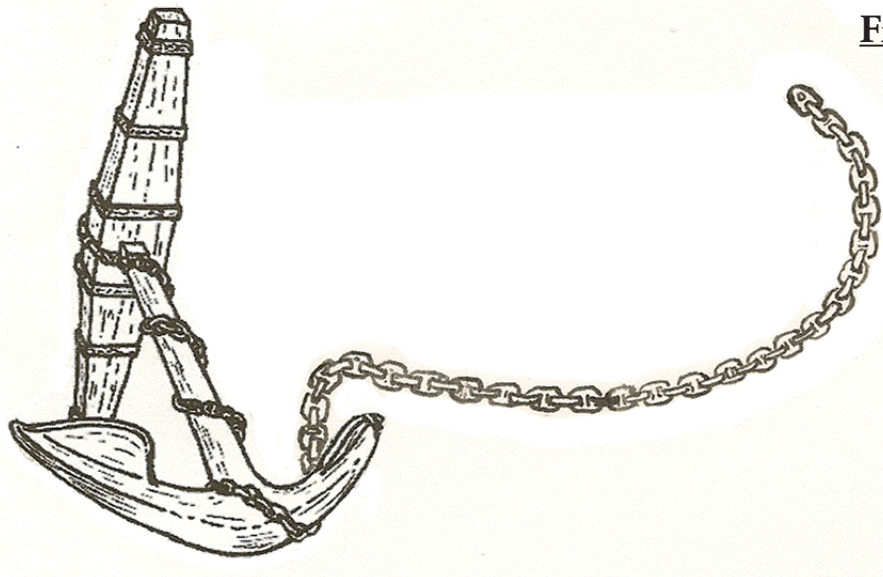

## *A Look to the Past*

Going through some old history, found this item: Gaustav Barth, a charter member, our 1940 Commodore and 1943-44 President of P.I.C.Y.A., said that the reason we called our Club "Sequoia" was that the defunct Redwood City Y. C. may have had some encumbrances the that new club did not want to incur. The "Barth Trophy Race" over Labor Day weekend from San Francisco to Coyote Point is a modern memorial to Sequoia's second commodore.

We have a 1996 transcript presented by Commodore Emeritus William Oates and Past Commodore Jack Wahle and moderated by Bob Hoffman. They speak of a barge that the Club bought and had towed in. It is described as an "old Navy rearming boat with a 10+ foot beam and maybe 25 - 30 feet long. It had sort of a plywood super structure on it. They held their board and committee meetings on it, but don't recall using it for any general or social functions." The old R.C.Y.C. building was still on the property and the club continued to use it for their socials. Boundary Slough was dredged and "C" dock was in place. These events seem to have occurred in the early 60's.

Some members wanted to build our clubhouse on the point where the Conference Center is located, but the Port felt that the site was better suited for a restaurant. Some club members tried to influence the Port to give the site to the Club by putting up some cash. Charley Brown built their restaurant on the site. They moved it back a bit when Club members mentioned that their proposal might interfere with the sailing basin and the entrance to the marina. Later, the members agreed that our present site was better in that it was sheltered and overlooked the Marina,

That's it for now, more to come later.

# *For Nauti Girls & Buoys*

## The Original Nauti-Girls

Have you ever wandered into the club on a Tuesday night, and see a group of people playing cards in the corner? Or see in the Club Calendar “Card Night” on Tuesday nights? Do you ever say to yourself, “That looks interesting. I wonder who they are and what they are playing?”

Card Night was started by past Women’s Auxiliary President, Zona Caesar, who still drops in on Card Night whenever she’s in town. On this one evening a week, members gather for a shared meal, a friendly game of Progressive (Contract) Rummy, conversation, and some rollicking good time.

So, just who are these card players? The past and current players range in ages from early teens to, well, we’d rather not say. It’s just not polite to mention age. They have an average membership seniority of 10 years with Sequoia Yacht Club, and have held a variety of positions at SYC, both formal and informal. Amongst the players, they have been club directors, treasurers, secretaries, port captains, social chairs, spouses of past commodores, women’s auxiliary presidents, and have hosted numerous events at the club. Roberta Barnes even started a previous incarnation of Nauti-Girls when she started a series of on-the-water safety programs geared toward the women members in the yacht club. Talk about a mind trust of SYC history!

We would like to extend an invitation to all club members who enjoy an evening of good company and a game of cards to join us. Although the “regulars” are primarily women, both men and women are welcome.

Dinner starts at 18:30. There is a different “chef” each week. The chef and the number of meals are determined the week before. However, if you don’t want to commit or have special dietary needs, and would just like to drop in on the group, bring your own meal. Dessert is usually served between 4th and 5th hand.

Just what is Progressive Rummy? This is also call Contract Rummy. There are 7 hands in total, but we play only six. The player is dealt a set of cards (10 cards for 1st-4th hands, and 12 cards for 5th-7th). The player must meet the contract in order lay their cards down on the table. First person to lay down all of their cards, wins the hand. Scores are tallied for each hand. Winners of each hand and the evening’s winner receives a prize.

A book: a set of 3 or more cards of the same rank; for example, 2 of hearts, clubs, and spades.

A run: a sequence of 4 or more cards of the same suit; for example, jack, queen, king, and ace of hearts.

1st Hand: 2 books

2nd Hand: 1 book, 1 run

3rd Hand: 2 runs

4th Hand: 3 books

5th Hand: 2 books, 1 run

6th Hand: 2 runs, 1 book

Don’t like Rummy? Bring some friends and start a game of cribbage, dominos, or poker. Whatever strikes your fancy. Come on down on Tuesday nights and join in on the fun! Questions?
