



December was an eventful month for the SYC racing fleet. Rumors continued to circulate that the SYC racing mark X had gone missing, but photographic evidence was obtained that proved that X was still in place. Although the previous buoy was found, it was replaced with a new 9-inch white cylindrical buoy with an orange band to improve visibility. If you are sailing near the San Mateo Bridge, sail by and check it out.

The Racing Pages on the Sequoia web site should now all be up to date for 2010. The Sequoia web site is a great resource for all club activities, especially club racing. Click on the SYC Racing tab to access the latest racing documents, schedules and results. The Winter Series continued on December 5 with race #2. There were 16 boats starting the race, including one from the Coyote Point Yacht Club. There were 13 boats in the spinnaker division and 3 in the non-spinnaker division. The race once again demonstrated just how fickle the winter winds are. What appeared to be good wind 15 minutes before the start of the race suddenly went away just before the first horn sounded.
